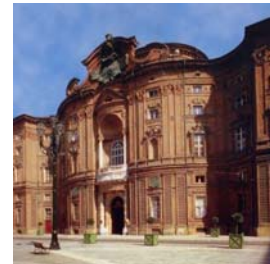

THE VENARIA ROYAL PALACE AND ITS GARDENS

Wednesday, September 16, 2009 (8:00 ÷ 13:00).

Walking tour, Min. 12 - Max. 25 participants.

Euro 30 per person.

Pick-up departure point: Torino Incontra Conference Center, via Nino Costa 8, Torino. Participants are kindly invited to be there at least 10 minutes before departure time. The tour includes private transfer bus to the Venaria Royal Palace, and back.

Lunch and entrance ticket to the Palace and its garden ARE NOT INCLUDED, the cost of the entrance ticket is 8 Euro per person.



Walking guided tour of one of the most imposing of the Savoy hunting residences around Torino, and its gardens. Restored to the baroque magnificence that inspired it when it was built in the mid 17th century for duke Carlo Emanuele II di Savoia, the Reggia of Venaria Reale has become a symbol of modernity and culture once again. Its inauguration, in October 2007, after two centuries of abandon and decay, and eight years of intense restoration, was an essential stage of the project to recover Venaria Reale: promoted by the European Union and sponsored by the Ministry for Cultural Heritage and by Regione Piemonte, it has been described as the most important project for the rehabilitation of a cultural asset in Europe. In the first year since it opened to the public, Venaria Reale has welcomed approximately 950,000 visitors. Venaria Reale, which was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, is at the centre of the circuit of Royal Residences in Piedmont and is the “access point” to the Corona di delitiae, that will be linked to the Royal Household and the concentric museum system in the city of Turin, included in the calendar of events for 2011 to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the Unification of Italy. MNC: THE ITALIAN NATIONAL MUSEUM OF CINEMA

In 1941, a project of Maria Adriana Prolo, historian and collector, gave life to the National Museum of Cinema. Member of the Fédération Internationale des Archives du Film (FIAF) since 1953, the Museum became a Foundation in 1992, thanks to the support of the Piedmont Region, the Municipality of Turin and the Province of Turin, of the Cassa di Risparmio di Torino and of the National Museum of Cinema Association. The Museum is located inside the Mole Antonelliana, designed by the great mind of Alessandro Antonelli, and was inaugurated in July 2000.
